1. AB 802.

In addition to requiring the utilities to provide whole-building energy usage data for commercial buildings and residential buildings with five or more accounts, it addresses the baseline issue. It's gotten very little play, but this is huge! The bill allows utilities to provide incentives for actions and measures that bring buildings into conformity with, or exceed, Title 24.

2. EE Rolling Portfolio decision.

It was held to Oct. 1, so by the time of our meeting it could be adopted. It is possible that the decision considered will be different than the link above.

3. Distribution Resources Plans.
